**Kaliber Stables
Horsemanship Program and Instruction

Lessons

GROUP

***Minimum of 3 Students per class**

- \$30.00 per group lesson/\$120.00 monthly if paid a month in advance
- Minimum of 4 lessons
- \$35.00 per group lesson if paid per lesson

Semi-Private *2 people per class only

- \$40.00 per semi private/\$160.00 monthly if paid a month in advance
- Minimum of 4 lessons
- \$45.00 per semi private lesson if paid per lesson.

PRIVATE

- \$50.00 per private lesson/\$200.00 if paid a month in advance
- Minimum of 4 lessons
- \$55.00 per private lesson if paid a per lesson

****NOTICE****

If an assigned group should drop to a semi private class because of fluctuations in clients scheduling needs for longer than 3 weeks, the remaining persons in that class will be notified that their fee schedule will reflect the semi private fees. All efforts will be made to fill the open slot to resume to group pricing but will not be guaranteed. The same applies to a semi private dropping to a private.

Discounts

Family Group/Family Semi Privates *2-5 Family Members

- Group or Semi Private fees apply less a 10% discount for total monthly amount
- Discount does not apply to private lessons.

Advanced Lessons Opportunity Sessions

As a full time students/ weekly lessons of Kaliber Stables, students are privy to Activity Sessions. These sessions vary from shows to fun activity sessions and trail rides. All activities are considered lessons and part of the Horsemanship Program. Depending on the level of the rider and involvement, advanced lessons are offered to encompass said activities Monthly lesson fees will be prorated appropriately depending on desired involvement and acceptance into the advanced lesson sessions.

Riding agreement and release form must be completed by participant or parent for minor.

Policies

- A 24 hour notice for any lessons canceled is required. Notice later than 24 hours or a no call/no show will result in a forfeited session/lesson unless there is an absolute emergency or if a conflict arises, clients may re-schedule within the same week without penalty upon availability. If there is no availability or if there is no attempt to make up the lesson up within the week the lesson will be forfeited. A 4 week session must be completed within 5 weeks from the date of purchase. This will be strictly enforced.
- Instructor cancellation or rescheduling does not apply to expiration time frame. If any client is aware of an extended absence, or other weekly obligations that may present consistent scheduling conflicts we ask that you utilize the pay-per-time feature. Payment for all services expected upon receiving said services. All past due amounts will result in a \$15.00 late/non-payment fee each week payment is not received. A \$25.00 NSF fee plus bank charges will be enforced

for all returned checks. If more than one check is returned for NSF payment will be limited to cash or credit card. Services will resume when payment is received in full. No exceptions.

- **Monthly lesson packages ensure a reserved time slot. Clients that choose the pay-per-time feature are subject to possible time changes.**

Inclement Weather: For the safety of the students and horses, certain circumstances prohibit riding. It is up to the discretion of the instructor to decide if the weather is a safety concern. If it is decided that the conditions are too dangerous to conduct lessons, the instructor will make an attempt to contact each person to notify them of the cancellation. If you do not receive a call or a message and you question if there are lessons, please call your instructor. Should you not speak with them personally; a voice mail message will be left if the classes are canceled. If you do not receive a call or do not hear a cancellation message, assume lessons are running. If you still choose to not attend you will be charged.

***Instructors reserve the right to hold classes in undesirable riding conditions and focus on other aspects of Horsemanship than riding. This is apart of the Horsemanship Program and is equally important to the students education.

Proper riding Attire: Students/clients are required to wear proper riding attire. This includes: long pants suited for riding, boots with a flat heel (Roper style/Paddock boots) and a helmet rated for horseback riding for those less than 18 years of age. Helmets/attire will *not* be provided by the Kaliber Stables. Clients who do not come to the lesson in proper attire will *not* be able to ride and will forfeit. No exceptions.

Monthly Invoice/Lesson Tracking: Clients have the right to request a monthly invoice or receipt for payment(s) If you do not wish to receive an invoice, your lessons will be tracked for quality control purposes. At any time you may request to know how many lessons are left in a package. It is up to the client to provide documentation of lessons used or not used if a disagreement arises.

Safety: All clients/students/attending parties and participants are required to maintain the highest level of safety possible. Any person(s) disregarding this policy may be asked to leave the property and may result in a refusal of service. This includes and friends or family members that may attend a lesson.

Right to Refuse Service: Kaliber Riding Academy/Kaliber Stables reserves the right to refuse service or discontinue any business relationship upon their discretion. Upon an immediate termination; parties will receive a refund of any monies owed and a written confirmation with signature from pertaining individual/parent/guardian acknowledging a satisfied refund.
